Lesson Times

Monthly lessons are available at a discounted rate and are scheduled based on availability of time slots. Lesson times are available from 1:00pm until 6:00pm Wednesday through Saturday.

Aside from the discounted rate, signing up for monthly lessons has major advantages. Having weekly scheduled lessons will ensure the same lesson time each week, and increase your progress. As well, within some months you will have 5 lessons during that month depending on the days of the month and the day of your scheduled lesson. For instance, there might be 5 Tuesdays this next month. This 5th lesson is free. In the event of a missed lesson, this will be used as a makeup, otherwise it will be a free lesson. Missed lessons should be avoided, and every effort should be made to attend all lessons.

Payment and Attendance Policies

- Monthly tuition is \$75.00 per month for 30 minute lessons, \$150 per month for hour lessons.
- Tuition for new students is prorated based on the number of lessons left in the month.
- Tuition payment is due before or at the time of the first lesson. Recurring student payments are due on the 1st of the month or during the first lesson in the first week of the month, regardless of attendance. Please make arrangements in advance.
- Payments not made by the second week of the month could result in loss of time slot.
- Tuition may be paid by cash, PayPal (dgedosh@gmail.com), or personal check.

- There is a \$25.00 service charge on all returned checks.
- No Refunds.
- Due to my student load and consideration of other students, the discounted rate, and the 5th week, make-up lessons will be given only under certain circumstances. Excessive absences can not be made up. Exceptions will be made solely at the discretion of the instructor and only if tuition fees are current. Missed make-up lessons will not be re-scheduled, and no make-up lessons will be credited or carried over to the following month unless prior arrangements are made.
- Lessons missed due to the absence of the instructor will be made up during the 5th week of the month if there is one, if not then a makeup lesson will be scheduled. If this is not possible it will be reflected in a reduction of the next month's tuition. Any 5th week lessons will not be re-scheduled.
- Any no call/no show lessons are forfeited. A forfeited lesson counts as a lesson taught because I was present to teach at the regularly scheduled time.
- Adult and teen students family members/guests are not permitted in teaching studio during lessons. I prefer not to have parents of younger children in the studio if possible. Younger students should be mature enough to have lessons on their own.
- Communication is important, as I do care about my students and families and don't want to worry, so don't hesitate to contact me if you miss or plan on missing.
